ABOUT THE SAMMAKKA SARAKKA CENTRAL TRIBAL UNIVERSITY

The Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University has been established in the District Headquarters of Mulugu, State of Telangana by an Act of Parliament- Act 36 of 2023 by an amendment to the Central Universities Act, 2009. The Bill was passed by the Lok Sabha on 7th December, 2023. The University will offer Graduate, Post Graduate and Doctoral level programmes. The University has been named “**Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University**” on the Mother and Daughter dieties of Tribes of the region.

A total **335.04 acres** land is allocated by the Government of State of Telangana for the University. Mulugu District is formed out of parts of erstwhile Warangal District and Jayashankar Bhupalpally District on February 17, 2019. It is surrounded by Jayashankar Bhupalapalli, Peddapalle, Mahabubabad, Warangal Rural.

The University will operate from a Transit Campus located in Jakaram Village near to the District Headquarters of Mulugu till the construction towards permanent campus is completed.

How to Reach

By Rail:

Mulugu can be reached from Warangal/Hanamkonda Twin Cities which are well connected to major cities of India by rail. Warangal and Kazipet are major railway stations on the Hyderabad-New Delhi and Chennai-Kolkata route.

By Road:

Mulugu is well connected by road. Mulugu is connected by long-distance deluxe buses from major cities of the state. Direct buses connect Hyderabad to Mulugu, Mangapet, Badhrachalam at regular intervals and it takes about 5 hours from the State Capital - Hyderabad (191 Km) and one and half an hour from Warangal/Hanamkonda Twin Cities (40 Km).

Following the policy of the Government of India and the guidelines of the University Grants Commission, the University reserves **15%** of seats in each course for candidates belonging to the **Scheduled Castes** and **7.5%** for the **Scheduled Tribes**, with a provision for interchangeability between these two categories, wherever necessary. **Candidates should submit a copy of the certificate of their Caste/ Tribe from a Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar / Mandal Revenue Officer at the time of the counselling/ admission.**

ENTRANCE EXAMINATION

Conduct of Entrance Exams through Common University Entrance Test (CUET)/ National Testing Agency (NTA)

Admission to B.A. (Honours) in English and B.A. (Honours) in Social Sciences programmes are through National Level **Common University Entrance Test (CUET) – UG 2025** conducted by the National Testing Agency.

The University has decided not to have any cut-off marks in the Entrance Examination i.e., in the Written Test for admission to any Bachelor course for any category during the year 2024-25 but to draw the list in order of merit.
