Notification for Engagement of Guest Faculty

Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University (SSCTU), Mulugu invites applications from eligible candidates for engagement as Guest Faculty in the following academic departments of the University. The essential qualifications shall be as prescribed under the UGC Regulations, 2018 and subsequent amendments issued from time to time. The engagement shall be purely temporary and initially for a period of eleven (11) months. The engagement may be extended further depending upon the academic requirements of the University, availability of workload, and satisfactory performance of the candidate.

Interested and eligible candidates may submit the duly filled-in application form, detailed Curriculum Vitae (CV), and supporting documents through both the prescribed Google Form and the designated email address on or before **19.06.2026**. Submission through both modes is mandatory. **Candidates are advised to carefully read the instructions before filling and submitting the application.**

Emoluments: As per current University norms, Guest Faculty will be paid an honorarium of Rs.1500/- per lecture subject to a maximum of Rs. 50,000/- per month vide UGC guidelines No.F.25-1/2018(PS/MISC.) dated 28.01.2019. Also, as per F&A rules, 10% or 20%, respectively for those with and without PAN, may be deducted towards income tax, unless a certificate of exemption from a competent authority is submitted.

Note: The University reserves the right to consider enhancement of honorarium, beyond the prescribed rates, based on the recommendations of the duly constituted Selection Committee on the basis of academic qualifications, experience, specialization, professional achievements, performance during engagement, institutional requirements, and any other factors as may be considered relevant by the University, subject to approval of the competent authority. Such enhancement shall not be claimed as a matter of right by any candidate or Guest Faculty.

Instructions for submission:

1. Click on the "Click Here to Download the Application Form" link provided in the notification to open the application form.
2. After opening the application form, click on the "File" tab located at the top-left corner of the screen.
3. From the available options, select "Download" and then choose "Microsoft Word (.docx)" to download the application form to your device.
4. Fill in all the required details in the application form carefully and completely.

5. Affix a recent passport-size photograph in the space provided in the application form and sign the form at the designated place.
6. Scan the duly filled-in and signed application form and keep it ready for submission along with all relevant supporting documents.
7. Upload the scanned application form along with the required documents through the Google Form link provided in the notification.
8. Send the duly filled-in application form, Curriculum Vitae (CV), and scanned copies of all relevant supporting documents to the designated email address mentioned in the notification.
9. Relevant supporting documents include mark sheets, degree certificates, NET/SLET/SET certificates, Ph.D. certificate (where applicable), experience certificates, and valid SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS/PwBD certificates (where applicable).
10. Submission **through both modes**, i.e., the Google Form and the designated email address, is mandatory. Applications submitted through only one mode shall be treated as incomplete and shall not be considered for further processing.
11. Candidates are advised to retain copies of the submitted application form and supporting documents for future reference.
12. Applications received after the prescribed last date and time (**19.06.2026**) shall not be considered under any circumstances.

The last date for submission of applications is **19th June, 2026**. The application portal/form shall automatically close on the last date and time prescribed, and no further extension shall be granted under any circumstances.

General Instructions and Terms & Conditions for Engagement of Guest Faculty

1. Interested candidates may submit their Curriculum Vitae (CV) along with scanned copies of relevant documents (mark sheets, degree certificates, NET/SLET/SET certificate, experience certificates, caste/EWS/PwBD certificate, wherever applicable, and other supporting documents) through the mode prescribed in this notification on or before the last date of submission of applications.
2. Applicants shall ensure that all information furnished in the application is complete, correct, and supported by relevant documentary evidence.
3. Candidates are advised to submit self-attested copies of all supporting documents relating to educational qualifications, experience, publications, category certificates, and other relevant credentials along with the application.
4. Only shortlisted candidates shall be contacted by the University through email and/or other appropriate means for the further selection process. No separate communication shall be sent to candidates who are not shortlisted.
5. Qualifications and other eligibility conditions shall be governed by the University Grants Commission (UGC) Regulations, 2018, as amended from time to time, and AICTE norms wherever applicable.

6. The eligibility of candidates shall be determined with reference to the qualifications, experience, publications, and other credentials acquired up to the last date prescribed for receipt of applications.
7. Mere fulfillment of the minimum eligibility criteria shall not entitle a candidate to be shortlisted, called for interview, or selected for engagement as Guest Faculty. The University reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates to be considered based on academic merit, specialization, experience, and institutional requirements.
8. The University reserves the right to prepare a panel/waiting list of suitable candidates and utilize the same for filling future requirements arising during the validity period of the panel, as determined by the University.
9. The equivalence of qualifications, relevance of specialization, and eligibility of candidates shall be determined by the University, whose decision shall be final and binding.
10. The engagement of Guest Faculty is purely temporary, need-based, and for a limited period. Such engagement shall not confer any right upon the incumbent to claim regular appointment, absorption, continuation, seniority, or any other service benefits in the University.
11. The University reserves the right not to fill any or all the positions advertised and may increase, decrease, or withdraw the requirement of Guest Faculty in any discipline without assigning any reason.
12. The University reserves the right to shortlist candidates based on academic record, higher qualifications, experience, publications, specialization, and institutional requirements.
13. The number of Guest Faculty positions indicated in the notification is tentative and subject to variation based on the academic requirements of the University.
14. The engagement of Guest Faculty shall be subject to actual academic requirements, student enrolment, availability of workload, and continuation of programmes/courses. The University reserves the right not to engage or continue the engagement of Guest Faculty in the event of insufficient workload or any administrative exigency.
15. The University reserves the right to modify, withdraw, cancel, or amend any communication made to the candidate(s) at any stage of the selection process in the event of any inadvertent error, administrative exigency, or any other valid reason.
16. The University shall verify the antecedents and documents submitted by a candidate at any stage before or after engagement. If any information furnished is found to be false, incorrect, fabricated, misleading, or deliberately suppressed, the candidature/engagement shall be cancelled forthwith and the University may initiate appropriate legal or disciplinary action as deemed fit.
17. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS/PwBD categories shall be required to produce valid certificates issued by the competent authority in the format prescribed by the Government of India. OBC (NCL) and EWS certificates shall be valid for the relevant period (**on or after 01.04.2025**) as prescribed by the Government of India.

18. An undertaking shall be submitted by the candidate declaring that the publications and other academic credentials submitted by him/her are original and free from plagiarism. If any plagiarism or academic misconduct is detected subsequently, the candidature/engagement shall stand cancelled.
19. The engagement of Guest Faculty is purely temporary and may be terminated/discontinued by the University at any time, without notice and without assigning any reason. The University reserves the right to review the performance of Guest Faculty periodically and discontinue the engagement in the event of unsatisfactory performance, misconduct, indiscipline, poor attendance, non-fulfilment of assigned duties, violation of university rules, or whenever the services are no longer required in the interest of the University. The decision of the University in this regard shall be final and binding.
20. The selected candidates shall be required to join within the period specified by the University, failing which the offer of engagement may be cancelled and the University may proceed to engage another suitable candidate from the panel or through any other process as deemed appropriate.
21. The engagement of Guest Faculty shall automatically come to an end upon expiry of the approved period of eleven (11) months, without any notice, unless specifically extended by the University.
22. The selected Guest Faculty shall be required to undertake teaching, practical/laboratory work, evaluation, invigilation, mentoring, examination-related duties, student guidance, and any other academic or administrative responsibilities assigned by the University from time to time.
23. Guest Faculty shall abide by the provisions of the Central Universities Act, Regulations, Rules, Government of India instructions, and directions issued by the UGC/University from time to time.
24. Superannuated teachers may also be considered for engagement as Guest Faculty, subject to the applicable norms of the University and a maximum age limit of 70 years.
25. Guest Faculty shall not be treated as regular teachers of the University for the purpose of voting rights, membership of statutory bodies, or entitlement to any service privileges available to regular employees.
26. Guest Faculty shall not be entitled to allowances, pension, gratuity, leave, medical reimbursement, provident fund, or any other benefits admissible to regular employees of the University unless specifically provided under applicable rules.
27. Any corrigendum, addendum, clarification, modification, or cancellation relating to this notification shall be uploaded only on the University website. No separate communication shall be made in this regard. Applicants are advised to regularly visit the University website for updates.
28. The University reserves the right to conduct the interview/interaction in physical, online, or hybrid mode depending upon administrative requirements.

29. Canvassing in any form, directly or indirectly, shall be treated as a disqualification and may lead to rejection of candidature.
30. No correspondence regarding shortlisting, selection, or non-selection shall be entertained.
31. No TA/DA shall be paid to candidates appearing for the interview/interaction or for joining the assignment, if selected.
32. Reservation shall be implemented as per Government of India/UGC norms applicable from time to time. In the event suitable and eligible candidates are not available under the EWS category, the University may fill such position(s) in accordance with applicable Government of India/UGC rules, guidelines, and instructions in force at the relevant time.
33. In case of any dispute, ambiguity, or interpretation arising out of this notification or the engagement process, the decision of the University shall be final and binding on all concerned.
34. Any dispute arising out of this notification shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the courts having jurisdiction over Mulugu District, Telangana, where Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University is situated.
