Date and Venue

Date of Spot Admissions: **25 August 2026 (Tuesday)**

Venue: Sammakka Sarakka Central Tribal University, Jakaram Campus, Mulugu, Telangana

Eligible and interested candidates may report at the University Campus on the above-mentioned date for participation in the Spot Admission process.

Eligibility

Candidates seeking admission shall fulfil the eligibility conditions prescribed for the respective programme by the University for the Academic Session 2026–27.

Candidates are advised to carefully verify the eligibility requirements before attending the Spot Admission process.

Admission Process

1. Spot Admissions will be conducted subject to the availability of seats in the respective programmes.
2. Admission shall be offered strictly to candidates who fulfil the prescribed eligibility criteria and satisfy the requirements of the University.
3. Selection/admission shall be made in accordance with the applicable University admission rules, merit/priority criteria and availability of seats.
4. Mere participation in the Spot Admission process shall not confer any right to admission.

5. Admission will be confirmed only after verification of the required documents and fulfilment of all prescribed conditions.
6. Candidates shall be required to produce the original documents/certificates along with the required copies at the time of admission.
7. Candidates shall be required to pay the applicable admission/academic fees within the prescribed time after selection. Admission shall be treated as confirmed only upon completion of the prescribed admission formalities and payment of applicable fees.
8. The University reserves the right to modify, defer, restrict or cancel the Spot Admission process, programme-wise intake, or number of seats available, depending upon administrative, academic, regulatory or other applicable requirements.

Documents to be Produced

Candidates should bring the following documents in original along with one set of self-attested photocopies, as applicable:

- Class X / Secondary School Certificate
- Class XII / Intermediate / equivalent certificate and marks statement
- Transfer Certificate (TC) in original
- Migration Certificate, wherever applicable
- Valid Government-issued Photo ID
- Recent passport-size photographs
- Category/Caste Certificate, wherever applicable
- EWS Certificate, wherever applicable
- PwBD Certificate, wherever applicable
- Other documents required as per the University's admission rules
- Relevant CUET/admission-related documents, wherever applicable

Candidates are advised to carry sufficient copies of all relevant documents.

Hostel Facility

Hostel accommodation is subject to availability and cannot be claimed as an automatic entitlement along with admission.

For candidates admitted through the above-mentioned Spot Admission process:

- Limited hostel accommodation is available for female candidates, subject to availability and fulfilment of the University's applicable hostel rules and allotment criteria.

- Hostel accommodation is **not available for male candidates** under these Spot Admissions.
- Hostel allotment, wherever applicable, shall be made separately by the University and shall be subject to availability of accommodation and the prescribed hostel rules.
- Candidates/parents/guardians are advised to make their accommodation arrangements accordingly and should not presume hostel allotment merely on the basis of admission to the University.

Important Instructions

1. Candidates are advised to report at the venue sufficiently in advance on **25 August 2026** and complete the admission formalities within the stipulated time.
2. Candidates must ensure that they meet the prescribed eligibility criteria before attending the Spot Admission process.
3. Admission is subject to document verification, eligibility, availability of seats and fulfilment of all applicable University requirements.
4. Candidates whose documents are incomplete, inconsistent or do not satisfy the prescribed requirements may not be considered for admission.
5. The University shall not be responsible for any delay or inconvenience caused due to incomplete documentation or failure of a candidate to fulfil the prescribed eligibility requirements.
6. Candidates should regularly check the official University website, www.ssctu.ac.in, for any updates, changes or additional instructions relating to the Spot Admission process.
7. The decision of the University regarding eligibility, document verification, selection, seat availability and admission shall be final, subject to applicable rules and regulations.
8. No candidate shall claim admission merely on the basis of attending the Spot Admission process or participating in counselling.
9. The University reserves the right to issue further instructions, wherever necessary, in the interest of the smooth conduct of the admission process.

Important Note

Spot Admissions are subject to the availability of seats in the respective programmes. Candidates are advised to attend the Spot Admission process with all required original documents and copies.
